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about my work

With my films, installations and expanded cinema works I often explore techniques of moving image production and presentation in relation to film aesthetics and perception. Therefore the disclosure of cinematic techniques, loops, found footage, DIY- and analogue technologies are an integral part of my work. For ten years, I've been an active member of the artist-run filmlab LaborBerlin e.V., a space that allows filmmakers to process and produce analogue films, independent from any industrial constrains. The aesthetics of contemporary popular Indian culture have become another strong influence in my works. Over the last twenty years I have spent a significant amount of time in Mumbai where some of my projects have been made. Recently, I've become fascinated with the topic of the film city, especially against the backdrop of inequality and overpopulation in an dystopian urban India of today. After exploring this theme in a fictitious way with my expanded work Camera Threat, I am now exploring the dark side of the Indian film industry with a hybrid documentary approach in my current project Strugglers.





Veterans of the Indian film industry talk about the decline of their analogue film craftsmanship. Residents of a ramshackle building in Mumbai shoot the collapse of their own homes with their mobile. Indian fans of a US wrestling star print their own selfies on a hoarding in order to express their birthday wishes to their idol.




expanded cinema, work in progress, approx. 15 min, stereoscopic 3D film projection, Super-8 mm, no dialogue

Artefacts from the golden times of small gauge amateur film take centre stage: Ready-made film transitions from the 1970's and 80's, colourful patterns for the ambitioned amateur filmer to be intercut into their home movies. This project brings them back to life and emphasizes on their opulent aesthetics in a stereoscopic 3D film projection.

Found footage: An expat Indian couple in the US of the 1960's presents their recently gained wealth in front of the camera. The peaceful images are juxtaposed with a hateful voiceover, lifted from the soundtrack of the fundamentalist Christian propaganda film "Streets of the Walking Dead" (1954).

The Super-8 film Batagur Baska (page 21) is being projected into a thick artificial fog. For a long time the images keep floating above the heads of the audience, eventually they get dispersed in the fog. Meanwhile the experimental music by Guido Möbius pervades the space with strange harmonic microphone feedbacks.







superimposition of images in double projection









Found home movies by an unknown family from West-Berliner from the 1970's and 80's. After purchasing a new camera with sound recording features, they shot most films accidentally out of focus. The manually edited film consists only of blurry footage which guides the focus to the colours, movements and the original magnetic soundtrack.


film installation 2014, three super-8 film loops withrotating mirrors and five bean bags, English voiceover — in collaboration with Eric Wilhelm da Cruz







